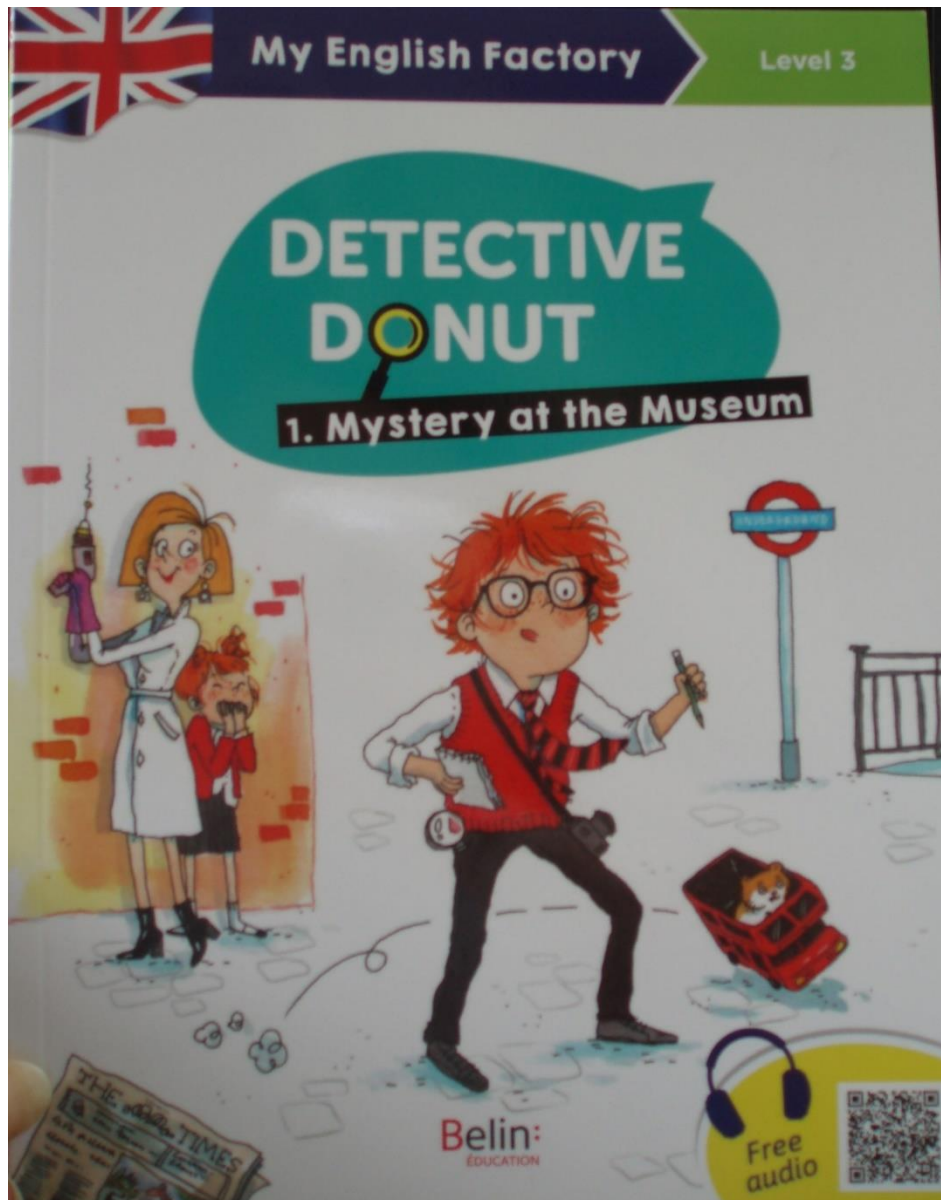


MYSTERY AT THE MUSEUM

and so clever!



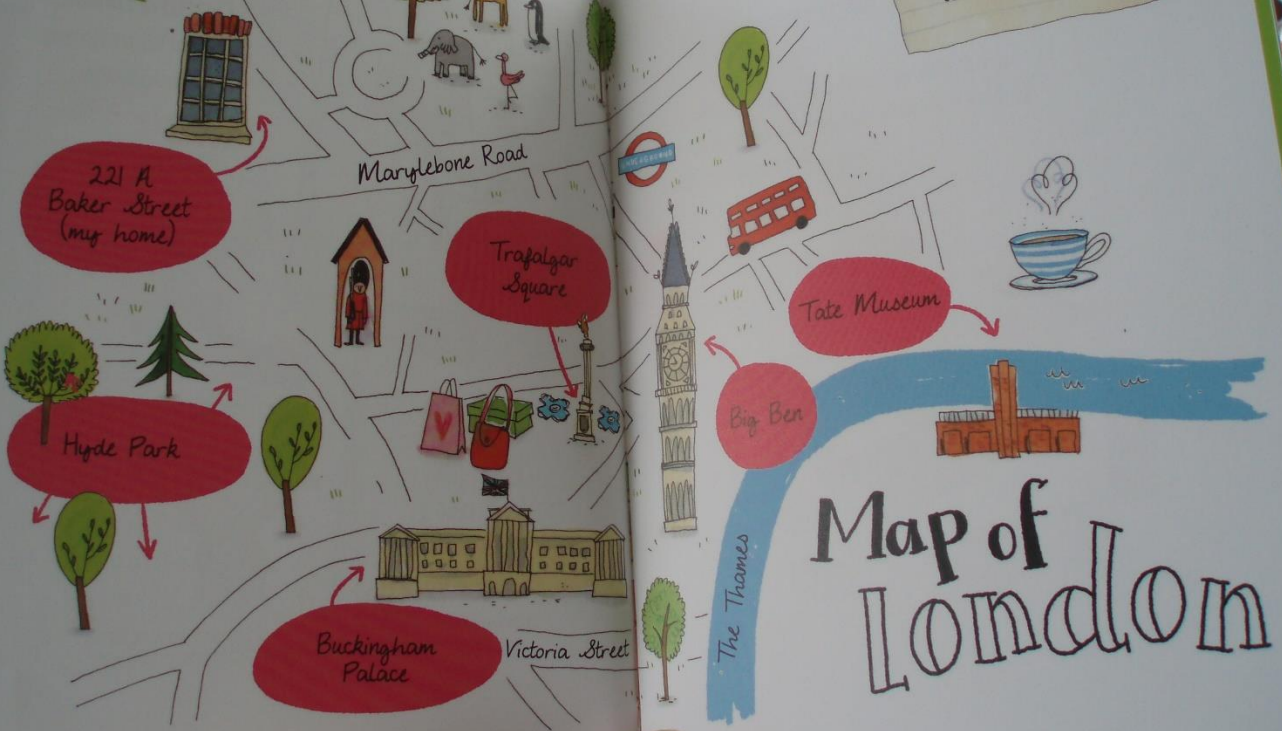
This is my Mum,

Lisa

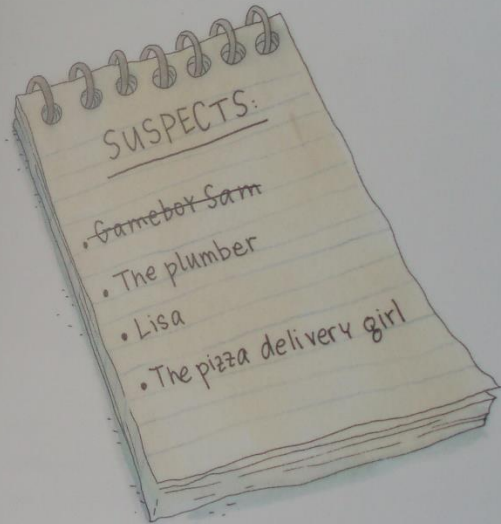
She's our neighbour,

The pizza delivery girl

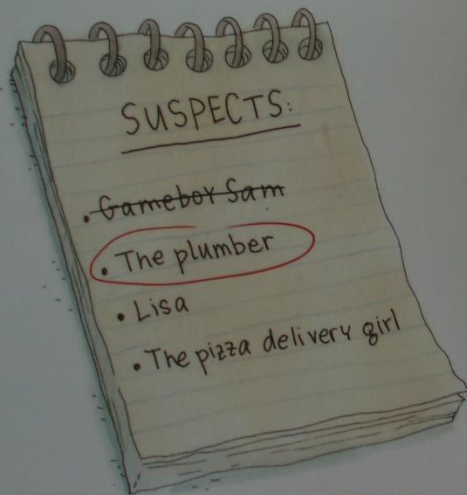
We always have pizza
