



Stationery List, Session 2021-2022

The following is the stationery to be brought the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school in September. The list is complete for the moment but if we find we require extra items, we will let you know as we need them. **Please name all items so that they can be quickly returned to their owners if they have been misplaced. Please also name your child's clothing so that we can identify items found in the playground, easily.**

- School bag (*cartable*) **not** a back pack
- pencil case with:
  - 1 graphite pencil
  - 1 blue biro pen (*not the kind that erase*)
  - 1 biro green pen, 1 biro red pen
  - small metal ruler 15 cm that fits in the pencil case
  - eraser, pencil sharpener with 'réservoir'
  - glue stick
  - 1 pair of scissors (*left handed if necessary*)
  - 1 yellow highlighter
  - feutre ardoise
- 30 cm metal ruler or rigid plastic (not bendable)
- 1 ardoise blanche + chiffon + 1 feutre
- 2 packets 12 x coloured pencils
- 2 packets colouring markers (*pointes moyennes*)
- 3 chemises (plastiques) à rabats et à élastique (24x32; 1 rouge et 2 vertes)
- 2 'chemises box' ROUGE à rabats et à élastique (24 x 32) with a 2,5 cm spine with name on the spine
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 porte-vues personnalisable 60 p. (You should be able to slide a A4 paper into the slot of the front cover.)
- 2 old pencil cases to put their extra supplies inside: Each should properly zip with your child's name clearly marked on the outside. One pencil case will be left in French class and the other in English class. In each 'stock'/'reserve' there should be 6 graphite pencils, 3 blue biro pens, 1 biro green pen, 1 biro red pen (*not the kind that erase*), 3 rubbers, 3 glue sticks, 4 markers for their white boards and 1 yellow highlighter.

Please note: Your child will be switching classrooms which is why we need double of many of the materials.

The children will need most of these items **every day**, so **please** check the contents of the school bag regularly. We will systematically send home the stock before each holiday.

**Please check, daily, The Blue Book and Blue Folder which we will provide on the first day and messages sent via KIDSCARE. These will be a point of contact between home and your child's teacher. All notes need to be signed to let us know you have seen them. We will also initial any messages from you. The BLUE BOOK will also be used as a homework notebook.**

Later on in September we will have another meeting after school to discuss how we work and how you can help your child.
